Minutes: Minutes read by John Hohman; First Rhoda Proper; Second Gary Terrill; approved as amended.

Old Business

- Triple-Crown data - discussion about not hearing much about this event; Jim Rohen related that \$75 is being spent by the car club, one of four clubs, participating; John Hohman and Rhoda Proper spoke about not having any data about participants and that the data should be shared with all participating clubs; Gary Terrill related that Bill Bradfield's system is done by longhand; it was suggested that our club take over; Jim Rohen will call Bill Bradfield and share our concerns.
- Clothing Orders – 40 hats ordered from BKD embroidery; \$9 per hat; hats were ordered a month ago and have been promised for mid-July; 100 shirts ordered from Kelgraphics after the design was adjusted; total shirt order came to \$720; shirts should be received in two weeks.
- Father's Day Cruise report: restaurant destination was Elly May's in Weidman; 13 cars participated; a great time was had by all.
- Sugar-Ray's Event – a repeat event is scheduled for the 3rd Saturday of July (21st) and August (18th) from 3 to 5 PM; last month 15 cars were present, 5 were guests from Reed City.

New Business

- Update on Car Show – discussion about tents for the 25th exhibition and replacement of registration canopy; Rhoda Proper will check on prices to rent and buy a large tent; Joe Sterly will check for a replacement canopy; Jim Rohen suggested that the 2019 Car Show should consider starting at 8 am instead of 7 am.
- Final Discussion: 25th Anniversary activities – one large prize will be selected to give away in celebration of the 25th Anniversary; tent with memorabilia will be set up at the Car Show.

- New Members – Potential new members John and Mary Ann Singer were in attendance; John Hohman related that there were only 14 members (currently paid) and he publicly paid his membership making it 15; there were 34 paid members in 2017; John Hohman suggested that the next few agendas should discuss membership recruitment ideas; it was also expected that new members might come from the scholarship, but there were no applications this year.
