Old Business

- Triple-Crown data requested on 10-11-17 for inclusion on the website, that was requested by members, has not been received from Bill Bradfield (tabled until resolved) – read from minutes.
- Adopt-A-Highway Report – Ken reported “All Done”; no further discussion occurred regarding: how the announcement was made, number of people attending, or details of the event.
- Bylaws; Vote to “reaffirm” the existing bylaws – An affirmative vote of the members present was received. Bylaws for 2017 are now reaffirmed for use during 2018.
- Joseph Guyton Memorial and Celebration – The observance will be Memorial Day at 2:00 PM. No official car club involvement is necessary, but organizers would appreciate the attendance of members.
- Sugar-Rae’s Restaurant – Deb Pacheco, Sugar Rae’s, was in attendance. It was agreed that those who can attend (with cars or not) will meet from 3:00 to 5:00 PM on Saturday, June 23rd. The event and attendance will determine planning for future events like this.

New Business

- Car Show insurance request from the city – Bill Foster, city commission, told us the city will require us to provide insurance for the car show with the club named as “primary” and the city as “secondary.” The city shares liability exposure because the car show is held on city property. This came up as a result of a city audit. Jim Rohen with the Marion car club which pays \$100 to the city of Marion for their show insurance and the city is responsible for the insurance policy. Jim Rohen will present the Marion scenario to the Evart commission.
- Mecosta Osceola food bank car show – This will be held during “Hersey Heritage Days”, Saturday, June 9th. Car Club were asked to line up at the “gas station” at 10:30 AM for an 11:00 AM parade.
- Father’s Day cruise – The date is set for Saturday, June 16th. Meeting time is assumed to be: 12:00 Noon assembly at Fosters and leave shortly after. The destination will be announced at the next meeting.
